Thank you to our President Elect Tina Beaman and to Danelle Fulawka for organizing the Spring Seminar.

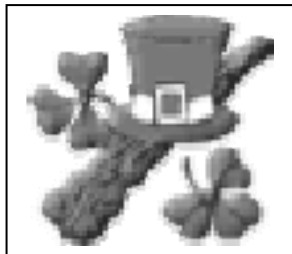

So you could potentially have three door prize tickets. As in all our meetings, snacks, coffee and tea will be provided

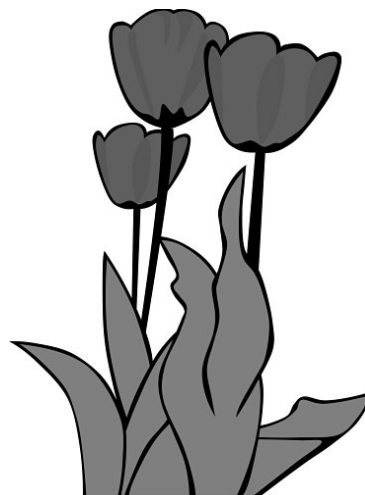
Spring Seminar April 19, 2008
